## FOUR SEASONS 四季 Sì jì

The seasons in Australia occur at the opposite time to the seasons in China. This week let's learn the seasons in Chinese. 春chūn夏xià秋qiū冬dōng is a common phrase in Chinese which describes the four seasons. Spring 春天 is seen as the first season of the year and Winter 冬天 is seen as the last season of the year.

### Spring 春天 chūn tiān

Australia—September, October and November China—March, April and May

#### Summer 夏天 xià tiān

Australia—December, January and February China—June, July and August



# Autumn 秋天 qiū tiān

Australia—March, April and May China—September, October and November

#### Winter 冬天 dōng tiān

Australia—June, July and August China—December, January and February








