HSK LEVEL 1 COURSE (HSK1A)

The HSK Level 1 Course run by the Confucius Institute at the University of Adelaide is structured in line with the HSK Level 1 requirements. The course is set to help individuals develop their Mandarin in a systematic and efficient manner and focuses on training students' integrated language ability including listening, speaking, reading and writing skills. The essential ideas of the communicative approach and task-based language teaching will be applied in the course.

By the end of the HSK Level 1 course, students will learn 150 words and be able to understand and use very simple Chinese phrases to make simple conversations on self-introduction, expression of gratitude and apology, numbers, time and date, weather, etc. Students will also learn to write simple characters.

The full HSK Level 1 course is set to be delivered in two parts: HSK 1A course and HSK 1B course.

This HSK 1A course is designed for students who have no prior knowledge of Chinese or with very limited Chinese.

Course Duration:

15 weeks (One 2 hour session per week)

Course Content (subject to change):

Lesson 1: Hello	Lesson 5: Her daughter is 20 years old this year
Lesson 2: Thank you	Lesson 6: I can speak Chinese
Lesson 3: What's your name	Lesson 7: What's the date today
Lesson 4: She is my Chinese teacher	Lesson 8: I'd like some tea

Class size:

Minimum of 5 and maximum of 10
